Refresh Rec's Point System

Refresh Rec uses a tier-based point system modeled after Volleyball BC to ensure teams are rewarded fairly based on performance. Points are not based on which division you signed up for, but on how your team performs in the playoffs.

How the System Works:

Teams register under a division (e.g., Open, AAA, AA, A) to help us seed and balance pools. This has no impact on final points.

After round robin play, teams are reseeded into playoff tiers based on their performance (e.g., Tier 1 = top performers, Tier 2 = next group, etc.).

Once playoffs are complete, teams earn points based on their final placement within their tier — not their original division.

Point Breakdown

Note: If your team finishes outside the top 8 in any tier, you'll receive the base points listed in the "9th+" column.

- 4. Creates a fun and competetive leaderboard
